# **"FAIRY-TALES ABOUT CHILDREN"**

Students and young people of basic, secondary, gymnasiums, specialized educational institutions, students of supplementary and non-formal education institutions, as well as individual young authors can participate in the competition.

The age of the participants is from 7 to 19 years. Participants are divided into three age groups.

THE TOPIC OF THE WORK FOR ALL GROUPS OF PARTICIPANTS IS ONE -AN ILLUSTRATION OF A FOLK-TALE IN WHICH THE MAIN CHARACTERS ARE CHILDREN:

- 1. I age group 7-10 years old.
- 2. II age group 11–14 years old.
- 3. III age group 15-19 years old.

The goals of the competition: to introduce, popularize, spread, encourage children's and youth's interest in fairy tales, the oral, sung and written legacy of folklore. To be interested in the biography of Jadvyga Čiurlionytė, the scientific legacy of her work.

Professor Jadvyga Čiurlionytė (April 13, 1898, Druskininkai – April 1, 1992, Vilnius) is a Lithuanian ethnomusicologist, doctor of art studies, professor, public figure. He wrote down about 4,000 Lithuanian folk songs, researched and systematized melodies, prepared their collections and the works of M. K. Čiurlionis for the press. Published music criticism articles. Created educational plays for the piano, songs. in 1925 He graduated from R. M. Breithaupt's piano class at the J. Štern Conservatory in Berlin, worked as a teacher in Klaipėda, Kaunas, Marijampole. 1937-1941 Archives of Lithuanian folklore and the Institute of Lithuanian Studies, 1941-1951. Research associate of the Institutes of Ethnology and Lithuanian History of the Lithuanian Academy of Sciences. 1944-1946 Vilnius University lecturer. Since 1946 Vilnius Conservatory, since 1949. Lecturer at the Lithuanian Conservatory, since 1969. doctor of arts, professor. 1948-1958 led the folk music cabinet he established at the conservatory.

### **OBJECTIVES OF THE COMPETITION:**

To organize a selection of competitive works, a virtual exhibition and an exhibition at the school to commemorate the 125th anniversary of the scientist's birth. Award and honor the winners of the competition at the opening of the exhibition of competitive works, which will be held in 2023 in April 6th Varena J. Čiurlionyte School of Arts.

### **TENDER CONDITIONS:**

All children and young people aged 7-19 are invited to participate in the competition. Painting or graphic works are performed using a freely chosen technique. Format A3, 3-4 works of one teacher, different authors are submitted for the competition, the other side of the work indicates the work topic, author, age, school (address and phone), teacher, e-mail. Works without frames. The teacher fills out the participation form of all his students, the work card, which is at the end of the contest regulations.
